PETITIONERS' MOTION FOR TURNOVER AND DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Petitioner, Christopher Ivy, the Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy (the "Petitioner" or "Independent Administrator"), for his Motion for Turnover and Distribution of Funds, states as follows:

A. Procedural Background

- 1) On April 6, 2023, this Court entered what Petitioner contended was a final and appealable order concluding on page 25 that: "Mordechai Faskowitz intentionally and unjustifiably killed Marjorie Ivy. Accordingly, Mordechai and his estate are barred under the Slayer Statute from receiving any benefit or distribution from the Estate of Marjorie Ivy." (the "April 6, 2023 Order")
- 2) Because the Respondent, Estate of Mordechai Faskowitz (the "Faskowitz Estate") did not timely file either a posttrial motion or a Notice of Appeal, on June 29, 2023, Petitioner presented a Motion to Distribute Funds.

- On July 28, 2023, the Faskowitz Estate filed a Notice of Appeal with the Illinois Appellate Court.
- 4) On September 15, 2023, the Independent Administrator filed Appellee's Motion to
 Dismiss the Appeal in its Entirety for Lack of Jurisdiction as Untimely, or, in the
 Alternative, to Dismiss the Appeal from the July 21, 2022 Agreed Order as not Subject to
 Appellate Review (the "Motion to Dismiss the Appeal for Lack of Jurisdiction")
- On September 29, 2023, the Faskowitz Estate filed its Response to the Motion to Dismiss the Appeal for Lack of Jurisdiction.
- 6) On November 7, 2023, the Appellate Court entered an Order granting the Motion to Dismiss the Appeal for Lack of Jurisdiction. A copy of November 7, 2023 Order is attached as Exhibit 1.
- 7) The Faskowitz Estate did not file either a Motion for Rehearing or a Petition for Leave to the Illinois Supreme Court.
- 8) On December 26, 2023, the Clerk of the Illinois Appellate Court forwarded the Appellate Court's Mandate that the final judgment of the Appellate Court was entered on November 7, 2023, which Order granted the Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie Ivy's Motion to Dismiss the Faskowitz Estate's Appeal for Lack of Jurisdiction. (the Mandate, which was received by the Clerk of the Circuit Cour of Cook County on December 28, 2023, is Attached as Exhibit 2).
- 9) Accordingly, this Court's April 6, 2023 Order that: "Mordechai and his estate are barred under the Slayer Statute from receiving any benefit or distribution from the Estate of Marjorie Ivy," is now indisputably a final and non-appealable Order.

B. Request for Turnover and Distribution of Funds

- 10) In light of all of the foregoing set forth in Section A of this Motion, the Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy requests that this Court order that:
 - (a) Bank of New York Mellon Company/Dreyfus turnover all funds in its custody, possession and control in the name of or belonging to Marjorie G. Ivy, Marjorie G. Ivy TOD and/or the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy, including, but not limited to, Account Nos. xxxx-xxxxxx2359 and xxxx-xxxxxx3708¹, to the Client Fund Account of Jeffrey C. Blumenthal Chartered for the distribution of (i) sixty-five percent (65%) of said proceeds to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy's administrative attorneys, Trostin, Kantor & Esposito, LLC, for further distribution to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy or the successor beneficiaries named after Mordechai Faskowitz, and (ii) thirty-five percent (35%) of said proceeds to the litigation attorneys for the Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy pursuant to the agreement between the Independent Administrator and said litigation attorneys;

¹ Pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Rule 138, only the last four-digit numbers of each listed account are set forth in this publicly filed Motion for Turnover and Distribution. A copy of the Motion for Turnover and Distribution with the account numbers listed will be submitted to the court in-camera.

² Only the first two Vanguard account numbers are listed on the Vanguard Statement for Marjorie Ivy as of June 30, 2023. However, because the Estate of Ivy's estate administrative attorneys had the other accounts listed as possible Marjorie G. Ivy Vanguard accounts, they are listed in this Motion to be as inclusive as possible.

percent (65%) of said proceeds to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy's administrative attorneys, Trostin, Kantor Esposito, LLC, for further distribution to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy or the successor beneficiaries named after the removal of the primary beneficiary, Mordechai Faskowitz; and, (ii) thirty-five percent (35%) of said proceeds to the litigation attorneys for the Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie Ivy pursuant to the agreement between the Independent Administrator and said litigation attorneys;

(c) The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County turnover the \$38,531.89, plus applicable claim interest, if any, deposited with the Clerk of the Circuit Court, pursuant to the May 23, 2014 Order entered in that case known as *New York Life Insurance and Annuity Corporation v Mordechai Faskowitz and Adrienne Russ*, docketed as Case No. 14 CH 01211 in the Circuit Court of Cook County ("Case No. 14 CH 01211") (a copy of which Order is attached hereto as Exhibit 3), which Case No. 14 CH 01211 was subsequently consolidated with this case, to the Client Fund Account of Jeffrey C. Blumenthal Charted for the distribution of (i) sixty-five percent (65%) of said proceeds to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy's administrative attorneys, Trostin, Kantor & Esposito LLC for further distribution to the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy or the successor beneficiaries named after the removal of the primary beneficiary, Mordechai Faskowitz; and, (ii) thirty-five percent (35%) of said proceeds to the litigation attorneys for the Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy pursuant to the agreement between the Independent Administrator and said litigation attorneys;

Wherefore, the Petitioner, Christopher Ivy, as Independent Administrator of the Estate of Marjorie G. Ivy, respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order granting the relief set forth in Section B, paragraphs 10(a), (b) and (c) of this Motion.

Upon motion to deposit the funds at issue and dismiss Plaintiff New York Life Insurance And Annuity Corporation (the "Company"), the Company seeks an Order directing it to distribute to the Clerk of Court proceeds in the amount of \$38,531.89, representing the death benefit payable in connection with Individual Annuity number N3 124 098 (the "Annuity"), which was issued by the Company to Marjorie Ivy, plus applicable claim interest, if any, (the "Death Benefit"), for deposit into an account with the Court; discharging the Company of all liability and dismissing with prejudice all claims against the Company relating to the Annuity and/or the Death Benefit; and appointing a Guardian ad Litem to represent the interests of Mordecai Faskowitz in this action or directing that no such guardian is required to be appointed; and the Court having considered the application of counsel, and for good cause having been shown;

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- That the Company shall distribute to the Clerk of this Court a check in the amount of \$38,531.89, plus applicable claim interest, if any, representing the full amount of the Death Benefit payable under the Annuity;
- That the Clerk of this Court shall deposit the Death Benefit distributed to the Clerk of
 this Court by the Company into an account and maintain the same pending further orders of the Court;



3. That upon deposit of the Death Benefit with the Court, the Company shall be, and hereby is, dismissed from the above-captioned action with prejudice and discharged from any and all liability to Defendants Mordecai Faskowitz and Adrienne Russ (collectively, the "Adverse Claimants") relating to the Annuity and/or the Death Benefit, and for the Adverse Claimants to be, and hereby are, permanently enjoined from making any further actual or implied claims, demands and causes of action, asserted or unasserted, express or implied, foreseen or unforeseen, real or imaginary, suspected or unsuspected, known or unknown, liquidated or unliquidated, of any kind or nature or description whatsoever, that Adverse Claimants, jointly and severally, ever had, presently have, may have, or claim or assert to have, or hereinafter have, may have, or claim or assert to have, against the Company with respect to the Annuity and/or the payment of the Death Benefit due thereunder;

4. That any and all claims against the Company relating to the Annuity and/or the Death Benefit be, and the same hereby are, dismissed with prejudice and without costs to any party; and
